

# SIMPLYHEALTH GREAT MANCHESTER RUN - SUNDAY 28 MAY 2017 ARCADIS GREAT CITYGAMES MANCHESTER – FRIDAY 26 MAY 2017

#### Dear Resident / Business occupier,

This year's Simplyhealth Great Manchester Run will take place on Sunday 28th May 2017 and includes the 10k, Junior and Mini events and a brand-new Half Marathon. We're celebrating 15 years of our hugely popular running event this year, and if you're not taking part or can't get out to see the action live, the event will be broadcast live on BBC 2 from 12:00 – 14:30 (please check local TV listings for up to date timinas).

A stellar elite line-up will feature some of the world's best athletes, who will head a field of 30,000 competitors. The day starts with the Simplyhealth Great Manchester Run Half Marathon at 09:00, followed by the Junior Run at 09:50 and the Mini Run at 10:50. Simplyhealth Great Manchester Run 10k Elite Wheelchair race begins at 12:30, followed by the Elite Women's race at 12:45 and the mass race will begin at 13:07.

A number of roads within the city will be affected by the events, and road closures and traffic diversion plans will be in operation on the day. We'll be installing warning notices seven days before the event and a copy of the full closures are listed below.

#### Saturday 27th May 2017:

Tonman Street from Deansgate to Barton Street from 08:00 until Sunday 28th 23:00. Access Tonman Street via Barton Street, access Longworth Street via Camp Street.

Sackville Street: from Portland Street to Major Street; Silver Street: from Minshul Street to Chorlton Street; Sir Alex Ferguson Way; Sir Matt Busby Way; Southmill Street; Trafford Road: from Exchange Quay to Trafford Road; Trafford Wharf Road: from Warren Bruce Road to Trafford Road; Warren Bruce Road: from Wharfside Way to Trafford Wharf Road; Wharf End: from Trafford Wharf Road to Trafford Road.

In alphabetical order, the following roads will be closed from 08:30 until 15:45:

**Albion Street:** from Whitworth Street West to Medlock Street: Medlock Street: from Albion Street to River Street: Whitworth Street: from Albion Street to Gloucester Street.

The following roads will re-open from 17:15: Portland Street; Chepstow Street; Great Bridgewater Street; Princess Street and Oxford Street.

All other roads in use for the course will re-open from 18:30 as soon as the course has been cleaned, with the exception of the following roads at the finish area: Deansagte from Whitworth Street West to Peter Street will reopen at 19:30 and St John Street will reopen at 21:00.

Residents living directly on, or with secured parking off, any of the above roads who will need to use their car on Sunday 28th May 2017 should use alternative parking away from those roads affected by the road closures.

Event stewards will assist traffic and residents wherever possible on the day of the race, allowing access to and from properties within the road closures whenever it is safe to do so up until 08:30. Please note that for safety reasons there can be no access onto the course after this time. We will endeavour to open roads as soon as possible.

### **CLOSURES FOR THE GREAT CITYGAMES MANCHESTER** PLEASE NOTE THE COURSE RELOCATION FROM 2016

On Friday 26th May 2017 Manchester will host the 9th Great CityGames Manchester which will see world class athletes competing in a number of different sprint events on a purpose-built track on Deansgate. The City and event will be shown in all their glory to millions watching the live BBC broadcast, so check local TV listings for up to date timings! In order to accommodate the track build, the following road closure will be implemented stopping ALL vehicle access to this section of Deansgate – please note that footpaths remain open to pedestrians, however there are no pedestrian crossing points available during the closures.

Deansgate will be closed between Quay Street and Great Bridgewater Street from midday Tuesday 23rd May to midday Saturday 27th May at 1200.

# **PARKING SUSPENSIONS**

On street parking suspensions will be in operation within the city centre for the duration of the events, the majority of which start at 04:00 on Sunday 28th May 2017. These suspensions will be signed clearly in advance in accordance with Manchester City Council protocol. Please do not park your car in any of the parking bays during the period of suspension, as it will be removed for safety purposes by Manchester City Council Parking Control, in accordance with their current uplift policy. There may be a charge to recover an impounded vehicle.

We apologise for any inconvenience our events may cause you, but hope you'll join us in celebrating this fantastic day of sport in the heart of Manchester. Full traffic diversion signage, approved by the police and relevant local authorities, will be in place across all areas affected by road closures.
