**Ella Chadwick**, from Rochdale, is returning to the Simplyhealth Junior and Mini Great Manchester Run.

The youngster survived forty gruelling operations in her first six years before having a life saving kidney from her Grandma. Ella will take on the run before helping to start the Simplyhealth Great Manchester Run 10k, which her mum Karen is running for the first time.
