

## **Event Specific Terms and conditions for the Community Challenge Element of the Bank of Scotland Great Scottish Run 2017**

Entries open to individuals able to attend and take part in the 10k at the Bank of Scotland Great Scottish Run which takes place on Sunday 1 October 2017 who have either registered or wish to register as part of these terms and conditions for the Community Challenge. Employees of Lloyds Banking Group Company are not eligible to enter.

Entrants must be aged 15 or over on the day of the event. As part of the Community Challenge, there is the likelihood that some filming will be required. Parental consent is required for all participants under the age of 16, prior to the commencement of any filming.

The Community Challenge place includes a free entry to the 10k, a bespoke training plan from a Great Run Company expert coach, 2 wristbands for the finish line hospitality marquee and an opportunity to share their story and promote their charity.

To enter please provide a short summary/story of up to 100 words about why you would wish to be considered for a place in the Community Challenge. Tell us why you are inspired to run and why you want to take part in the Bank of Scotland Great Scottish Run in 2017.

One individual will be selected from each local authority in Scotland. 32 in total. A panel at the Great Run Company will select the final representatives from each of the 32 local authorities and selection is at the organisers' discretion. The panel's decision is final.

The selected entrants will be required to take part in future publicity in connection with the Bank of Scotland Great Scottish Run and the Community Challenge such as social media and local/regional media.

Entries will be accepted from 9am on 13 June and the closing date and time is midnight on 27 June 2017.

After the closing date the selected entrants will be notified no later than Thursday 6 July by email.

The entry place is not transferable.

Runners already entered into the event, if selected, will have their entry fee refunded.

No Travel costs, costs or expenses are included.
