



# STIRLING SCOTTISH MARATHON

SUNDAY 21 MAY 2017

## Dear Resident/Business Owner

As you may know, Stirling is hosting the first ever Stirling Scottish Marathon on May 21st, and we are writing to let you know about traffic management on the day, which will help us make sure the event runs safely and smoothly.

The marathon, which is being supported by Stirling Council, in conjunction with Great Run, is expected to attract around 6,500 runners. It will start at 09:00, at Blair Drummond Safari Park and finish just off Raploch Rd in the City Centre. The aim of the marathon is to help people become more active and have fun, and to promote Stirling, Doune, Dunblane, Bridge Of Allan and the surrounding areas.

Before and during the run it will be necessary to implement a number of road closures along the route between 05:00 and 17:30.

These have been agreed with Stirling Council and will be phased, with closures running from 05:00 – 09:45; and re-openings between 11:00 – 17:30. Please note that these times are approximate and emergency vehicles will have access **at all times**.

The roads used by the run are listed in the table on this leaflet. If you need more detailed information relating to specific times and roads, please go to [greatrun.org/stirling](http://greatrun.org/stirling).

The roads will be reopened in a structured manner, following the last runners in the event. Event infrastructure will be removed and the roads cleaned ahead of them re-opening.

We would ask you to please ensure that cars are not parked on the route (see list of roads used by the route in the table opposite), and runners would be very grateful if cars can be parked in the closest side street. If you can tailor your travel plans around the timings of race day, we will make sure we open roads in a timely fashion.

\* The Underpass taking runners beneath Customs Roundabout will be managed to facilitate runners and pedestrians.

The A84 from the M9 junction will have restricted access up until Craigforth roundabout where it will then be closed through to Doune.

The A91 will be completely closed (northbound and southbound) only on the section from Manor Powis roundabout to Muirton roundabout on Sunday 21 May from 10:00 – 14:00.

If you are travelling into Stirling from the East, please use the Clackmannanshire Bridge southbound and enter Stirling via the A905 through Fallin.
